11/1 If you went to bed with a problem on your mind, you may awake to find a new outlook. Actions put in motion today have an excellent chance of working to your advantage, especially if you're operating with real purpose. **The Moon is VOC* from 5 to 6:08 pm ET.** Once the moon enters Aquarius, if you're not already home the night may go longer than you'd originally thought. 11/2 New ideas fly in with the shift of Mercury and Venus into Sagittarius. This signifies an increase in spontaneity and an influx of choices. You may encounter a conflict especially if you're enthusiastically moving and someone else is holding the line (or vice versa). This doesn't have to be a big deal; see the big picture. Excellent day to begin a project or stay with a vision. You can work through the hitches for an even better-than-expected outcome.

11/3 If you're a multi-taker by nature or love to network and be exposed to a lot of information, today may have a lively buzz for you. Even if this is not your MO, you may benefit from situations and people who are humming like bees. Late in the day/early evening pits strong desire against what feels safe, so tempers can be short. Be alert driving and potential "road rage". If you're feeling short-tempered, check in as to where you might have unaddressed needs. Even if there's no immediate solution, acknowledging the grievance helps. **The Moon is VOC* from 11:41 pm ET.**

**Moon VOC/Void-of-Course:... in Aquarius you are apt to get caught up in a discussion or a cause which has no resolution. This is an excellent time to visit with friends or bounce around ideas, for pure recreation. If you're trying to solve a problem, you can connect the dots much more effectively another day.*

11/4 Once you get out of your way in the morning (even if you think someone else is to blame), you can make headway on a project or goal. The Pisces moon is delicious for artists, writers or any conceptualists, including money managers. If you feel the impulse to see art, a garden or hear music, find a way to accommodate your desire. There may be an opportunity to forge a connection with a powerful ally; this might be as simple as striking up a conversation while waiting. Trust your instincts when you get a prompt to be friendly.

11/5 The Moon is **VOC* from 4:05 am ET through the rest of the day!** This is a perfect Saturday to drift and dream or clear out old business. Blessed are those who can make artwork or spend the day in trance. Avoid over-indulgence because tomorrow ends Daylight Saving Time in the U.S. and you will sleep best if you are appropriately tired and minimally wired.

**Moon VOC/Void-of-Course... in Pisces, creativity may be high, if one is already in the midst of a project. Inspiration is more fluid than electric. This is also an excellent time to meditate and do conscious prayer-work or volunteer activities.*

11/6 This is also the end of Daylight Saving Time for the U.S., so give yourself more time to organize your thoughts if you can in the morning. The moon is VOC* until 2:02 pm ET, so you may feel a bit of a "dream hangover", even if you're a teetotaler. Once the moon enters Aries, you may get a jolt to help carry you through a day in spite of lost sleep. Nonetheless, be aware that energy is uneven today, so traffic can be erratic. Just because you react to something, doesn't mean you can pop out a thought that's effective

without thinking it through. Channel excess energy into a physical activity, then plan how to get your ideas out and into action... you can move mountains over the next few days IF you take the time to forge the right alliances.

11/7 The first couple of hours after midnight ET can be fraught with power struggles; sleep through it, if you're in the right time zone! Otherwise, read yesterday's post- slowly. You may be full of tremendous desire, but a Mars/Neptune picture in the sky indicates possible roadblocks or resistance to action. Bide your time; see this as an opportunity to make your path sound, instead of an annoying detour. If you feel frustrated, get to the gym or take a walk but keep your head focused on the activity at hand.

11/8 Election Day pits the people against the status quo, so depending on where you live you may notice an "upset". Regardless, you may feel a bit thwarted, especially if you have cardinal signs in your horoscope: Aries, Cancer, Libra or Capricorn. If you find yourself bucking with authority or feeling tamped down, recognize that this is a temporary situation (even if it doesn't feel like it). You can observe it with the sense that there is a way to change it. Sometimes it's a matter of claiming your own authority; sometimes it means eliminating a relationship. Always, you benefit from clear-eyed evaluation. In the late part of the day, make time for meditation, creative exploration or a musical interlude. Some problems are not solved logically. Keep a notebook by your bed, because you may wake up inspired.

11/9 The moon is **VOC* from 12:46 am to 2:45 am ET.** Once the moon enters Taurus, you may notice things slow down. This is not necessarily a bad thing, depending on how you "do" life, but it may seem as though everything takes longer. Don't begin anything important; follow-through and/or finish projects. Take time to enjoy at least one meal today. Savor tastes, look around you, inhale, touch your companion or the fabric of a favorite garment. Judgments about investments or relationships can be an astute at this time, but take no direct action. Time is on your side.

Neptune goes direct, signaling a period when *Denial* returns in full force, so if you've been working on *transparency* you may see the curtain fall. Find time today to pray, reflect or meditate on strengthening your resolve to find the way in any difficult situation. Denial is never the solution, but to those who feel there is no course of action (or who don't like the course) it is always the knee-jerk reflex.

**Moon VOC/Void-of-Course... in Aries, do some movement- either exercise, walk or drive... because the desire to move forward can be thwarted by the VOC. If you're going somewhere new make sure you have clear directions and a map because fast movement can miss turns.*

11/10 Full moons often feel "big" and some are better aspected than others for completion and culmination of a thought or project. This particular day may feel loaded but not necessarily satisfying. Therefore it's important to give yourself a sense of fulfillment, regardless of judgment. For instance, plan a dinner party or enjoy a cultural event in the evening.

Another act of self-love is to cross something off your list. Yes, something that you haven't done yet; ideally something that you feel guilty everytime you see on the list but is not essential to your well-being. Cross it off your "to do" list. You may decide to jot it down again at the next New Moon or it may be something that you will never do. The important thing is that you take it off your psychic yoke... at least for now.

The Taurus Full Moon occurs 3:16 pm ET at 18°Taurus 05". The *Sabian Symbols* for these are: "A newly formed continent" for the Moon and "A parrot listening and then talking" for the degree of the Sun. When I picture of these images, I see hope, but its adversary, ironically is *Denial*.

The full moon in Taurus shines on our beautiful Blue Planet. To think in terms of a “new continent” is to remember theories about how our present geography was formed. If indeed our continents took shape through a shift of the poles, earthquakes, colliding asteroids, and/or Ice Age and thaws, then we might find the first phrase *scary*. However if we see it in symbolic terms, like the rising of Atlantis, then it indicates a brave, new world. On the other side, the parrot listens- but does the parrot “think”?

Traditionally we view someone who “parrots” as someone who repeats something without any thought behind it. This is the cloud of denial that can obstruct truth. At this time of the full moon it is important to allow your inner light to look clearly at issues to do with finances and to “take stock”. There is danger in thinking “what I don’t see won’t hurt me”. When the new venture (continent) presents itself, listen. When you talk, ask deeper questions. No one *wants* to be a parrot. Yet that “new continent” will not stay in place without listening and talking and spreading the word. Anyone who has ever known a parrot will tell you how smart they are, but it also depends on to whom that parrot listens.

when forging a “new continent”, like when the U.S. began, the hope and dreams of the founders is essential, but also decisions must be made. To quote Thomas Paine: “*Lead, follow or get out of the way*”. When a full moon shows aspects of tension and frustration, it is like a woman who’s pregnancy is overdue... something must come forth. It may not flow, but it’s got to happen.

Mars enters Virgo, initiating a cycle well positioned for a change in a health or exercise routine. You may also feel a call for volunteering or service over the next couple of months. This bodes well for practical application.

11/11 This morning, people may be a bit slow to react or even confused. A good breakfast helps. **The moon is VOC* from 11:27 to 3:10 pm ET.** Once the moon enters Gemini, things start to move very quickly. Watch out for darting cats, drivers jumping lights, unpredictable youth and bicycles. Phones ring, texts fly and you may get a spontaneous invitation you can’t refuse. Keep your eyes open and pace yourself. **Moon VOC/Void-of-Course... in Taurus, relaxation is demanded. You can try to accomplish a big task, but that couch looks awfully inviting. Give in and let yourself enjoy a leisurely lunch and your productivity will increase afterwards.*

11/12 Today’s Gemini moon suggests a great deal of activity, although not all of it may flow. It’s important to be clear and to consider one and other’s feelings. When life happens very quickly, the tendency is to forget the niceties, which can lead to miscommunication and regrets. By evening, signals untangle and the potential for an animated and delightful time is strong.

11/13 Fabulous day for visiting relatives and neighbors and/or for community events. People communicate and work together beautifully, spanning generations. An overall sense of spiritual connection can soften many platforms. If you need to “build a bridge”, consider this an opportunity for it. **The Moon is VOC* from 10:43 pm on.** Get off your computer beforehand unless you want to organize your email, otherwise you may wonder where your time went. **Moon VOC/Void-of-Course... in Gemini, conversations can be particularly misunderstood; avoid important correspondence or phone calls. Great time to clean out old emails and tidy up your desktop.*

11/14 The moon enters Cancer at 2:19 am ET. You may start your morning with great expectations and a love of your surroundings. As the day proceeds, you may encounter

a large challenge (or the news may blare on about deficits and terrorism). It's important to keep perspective and tackle the challenges you can. Don't overdo, if you're worrying, find an outlet. Swim, find a body of water to stare at or a tranquil room; Monet's waterlilies at MOMA can work on an off-hour. A quiet evening at home can soothe the spirit, or depending on your relationship with her, a conversation with mom (or a nurturing friend).

11/15 This is a good day for any enterprise to do with home or real estate, as long as you're not embarking on the project for the first time. Research is productive, especially personal or national history. Enjoy meals that comfort and satisfy, but whatever you do, don't forget to eat. Avoid discussions or arguments in the evening, because there may be a tendency for people to feel short-changed.

11/16 The **Moon is VOC* from 12:22 am to 11:17 am ET.** Once the moon enters Leo, you may notice more excitability around you, especially with fire signs (Leo, Sagittarius, Aries). Conversations may have a less predictable and more dramatic tone. Don't bite off more than you can chew with promises or scheduling, although by 5 pm you may feel you can crowd a lot of activity in one evening. A Mars/Jupiter picture in the sky can indicate a romantic evening, or one where athletic goals are achieved. Avoid any speculation with long-range consequences.

**Moon VOC/Void-of-Course... in Cancer, be by the water, time with family or sifting through memorabilia. Lovely time to enjoy a picnic or meal with no time constraints.*

11/17 People can and do have a great deal of fun today and you can be one of them if you're willing to play. Promises may be exaggerated and conversations though well-intended in the moment, won't necessarily pan out. If you're willing to suspend belief and be in the moment with no investment as to the long-term, you can have a wonderful time. Don't buy things you can't afford, no matter how compelling. Make good choices as to who you spend time with and what you do and enjoy yourself.

11/18 After yesterday's carefree fun, this morning may feel a bit crunched. Still, if you get off on a good foot, you may be doing better than you think. People may not be as cooperative or as forth-coming as you would like, but learn what you can and shore up the knowledge for later action. **The moon is VOC* at 2:06 pm until 5:19 pm ET.** Once the moon enters Virgo, your sense of potential accomplishment may increase. The way becomes clearer and you may meet or Stumbleupon a person or information that supports your journey.

**Moon VOC/Void-of-Course... in Leo, you do well to play: window-shop, go to a museum or performance, flirt, make some artwork.*

11/19 Today's Virgo moon supports organizing, cleaning or volunteer efforts. You might want to revisit or amend your exercise or diet program. A trip to the animal shelter or investment in a pet can bring you a wonderful companion. If you already have a pet, this is a fabulous day to spend with him/her. Meditative time spent alone or on a creative project is very satisfying, as is a visit with a therapist or wellness provider.

11/20 It may seem that whatever you try to do today is met with confusion and miscommunication. Stay with it; be patient. Sometimes in order to achieve harmony, you have to tune the instrument first. The end results of your day can be satisfying, which tastes all the sweeter because of the rough patches along the way. **The Moon is VOC* from 5:21 pm to 8:16 pm ET.** Once the moon enters Libra, unexpected events may occur. This can be as startling as a call from an old lover or a conversation with your spouse that makes no sense. Whatever happens, the key is in adaptability. Everything can settle down just as quickly, if you keep your head.

11/21 A good day for conversations, litigation, mitigation and compromise. I wonder if Congress will be in session? Make overtures to make nice or make peace. If you're

willing to do whatever work is required, you can reap rewards in relationship, whether business or pleasure.

11/22 A similar day energetically to yesterday, but with an even more powerful mandate to forge alliances. The Sun enters Sagittarius at 11:08 am ET, beginning the cycle of finishing autumn and clearing way for winter. The mood to think well of people increases and the desire for a just and expansive world. But this is not frivolous; if you have discussions about prospects, it is easy to discern who has the mettle to go the distance and who is simply here for the short run. Choose wisely. In the late afternoon/evening, you get magnified results from the enjoyment of spiritual and cultural activities. The Moon is VOC* from 6:04 pm to 8:58 pm ET. Once the moon enters Scorpio, the energy quiets down and you may want to plan to be home or with someone you are comfortable with for a tête-à-tête. **Moon VOC/Void-of-Course... in Sagittarius you may want to explore but don't expect to find anything... keep your eye on the gas tank if you go for a long ramble.*

11/23 This is an intense day, especially for water signs (Cancer, Scorpio, Pisces). If you like to write, get up a little earlier to make time for your early morning thoughts. With a Mars/Pluto picture in the sky, you may feel driven to do something, especially if you've been procrastinating it. This may or not make sense. Around the holidays (in the case of the U.S. Thanksgiving), if the impulse involves a family member, it behooves you to write out your thoughts beforehand. Once you have perspective on it, you might have a better idea how to proceed. This is a powerful day for deep conversations, just make sure you've an idea how far you're willing to go before you open it up.

11/24 Mercury goes retrograde at 2:21 am ET (where it will be until 12/13). If you're traveling for the holiday, give yourself extra time. If you're going to a new place, make sure you've got the correct address and phone number. Repeat back the time you're expected. **Thanksgiving Day** has a Scorpio Moon that goes VOC* at 6:05 pm ET. Up until that time, conversations can be loaded or meaningful, depending on the people involved. At 8:57 pm ET the moon enters Sagittarius, and if it hasn't already, the party begins. Be aware people may have a tendency to eat or drink too much, and considering the holiday, it's to your advantage if that part of the evening is done before the Sag moon. If not, be forewarned and be sure to drink plenty of water. A Venus/Neptune picture can promote loving harmony which may soothe ordinarily stressful relationships, as people seek common ground.

11/25 The Sagittarius New Moon is also a Solar Eclipse. Solar Eclipses open a doorway of insight- like a dream that seems crystal clear in the moment, but then we awake with only a fragment of clarity. The trick is to use the emotional charge from that "fragment" as a pulse to guide you forward. In Sagittarius, it's about a new beginning in travel, litigation, education. Is there something you've always wanted to study? Is it time to go back to school for a new career? Is there a legal matter or contract that is ready to be considered? What is your truth? What is your "must do" exploration?

The eclipse occurs at 1:10 am ET at 2' Sagittarius 37". Keep a notepad by your bed in case you awaken. You can jot down some thoughts, then go to sleep with confidence that if it has any meaning, you can look at it in the morning. The Sabian Symbol is "*Two men playing chess*", which reminded me of the movie, *The Seventh Seal* by Ingmar Bergman. It's must be the Swedish in me, but I love his films, and that one is full of allegory and images that have stayed with me since the first time I saw it. But I digress. The "*two men playing chess*" in the film, are actually Death and a disillusioned knight returning from the Crusades.

This intrigues me because Pluto is in Capricorn and Pluto symbolizes Death and Transformation. When Pluto was in Sagittarius, wars and killing was justified “in the name of God”. Since 2008, although that’s still going on, Capricorn’s realm of business, finance and “who’s in charge”, has changed the focus. It’s hard to sanction wars when no one knows who’s going to pick up the tab. Bergman’s film about a knight from the Crusades has great relevance.

When you invite in the energy of this New Moon, bring in your “lost saints”. These are the beliefs you’ve outgrown or discarded, in contrast to the truth that burns within you. Realize that not all those beliefs are necessarily false, but that it’s evaluation time. What is essential, it to recognize what matters most to you and get in synch with that. Open yourself up to what you must carve out time for and set out to do it as though this is your last chance. Do it with the knowledge that you are part of the Universal Spirit, the “I Am” force, and with that as your essence, everthing is possible.

11/26 Today Venus enters Capricorn, beginning a cycle of a practical outlook on money and love. How you deal with this has everything to do with how you’re hard-wired. This is a good day to put into action any of the impulses that were stirred by yesterday’s eclipse, or start the dialog or research. There’s a Venus/Uranus picture in the sky, which can indicate unexpected attractions or sudden demands on money or love. The **Moon is VOC* from 7:06 pm to 10:04 pm ET.** Once the moon enters Capricorn, it’s time to settle in for a quieter evening. **Moon VOC/Void-of-Course... in Sagittarius you may want to explore but don’t expect to find anything... keep your eye on the gas tank if you go for a long ramble.*

11/27 The Capricorn Moon suggests a day best spent attending to responsibilities and activities that give you a sense of accomplishment. Visit an elderly friend or relative. Take a look at your finances or help someone else. A Venus/Jupiter picture in the sky indicates this is not all about work, but that through the right effort, you relate to another and receive connection blessings.

11/28 Today may be a challenging day. Relationships can seem to be at crossroads and compromise elusive. You can bang your head against the wall, or you can listen to the differences and resolve to look at it another day. In this case, tomorrow truly can make a difference. Instead make a plan or outline, organize, tackle a problem, but save the interpersonal struggles for an energetically easier day. **The Moon is VOC* from 6:01 pm ET on.**
